This concert, featuring works by Schumann and Chopin as well as a toccata specially composed by Thomas Oboe Lee for **Mana Tokuno**, will benefit the Rebuilding Fund of the West Cummington Congregational Church, whose church building burned to the ground in January. See westcummingtonchurch.org

Ms. Tokuno, has been recognized for her brilliant virtuosity, her ability to bring a vast array of styles to life, and her sensitive and insightful interpretations. She has given solo performances at Carnegie (Weill) Hall and CAMI Hall in New York and at Symphony Hall and Jordan Hall in Boston as well as in numerous European locales.

First Prize winner of the prestigious Competition Internationalé, Ms. Tokuno has also received the Leo Sirota Award for Piano Solo Performance at the Corpus Christi International Competition, as well as the Special Award for Schubert Interpretation at the International Competition, Valsesia Musica, in Varallo, Italy. Other prizes include the Dosei-Kai Prize for Distinction in Performance, and the Silver Medal in the Chubu Chopin Competition in Nagoya, Japan.

Ms. Tokuno's principal teachers were Midori Tanabe at the Tokyo National University of Fine Arts and Music and Victor Rosenbaum at the New England Conservatory in Boston. Ms. Tokuno is on the faculty of Phillips Academy in Andover, Massachusetts and the New England Conservatory Preparatory School. Her first solo CD, "Beethoven Sonatas & Bagatelles" was released from GiNote Records in October 2009.

The Greenwood Music Camp is located at 32 Harlow Road in Cummington, MA, north of Route 9/112. Turn north onto Lilac Street, on the eastern side of the bridge over the Westfield River. At the fork in the road, bear right onto Nash Road. Take the first right onto Harlow Road and continue for ½ mile. To reach the performance hall, turn right onto the second driveway.
